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Vermont Commons School Presents *The Foreigner*

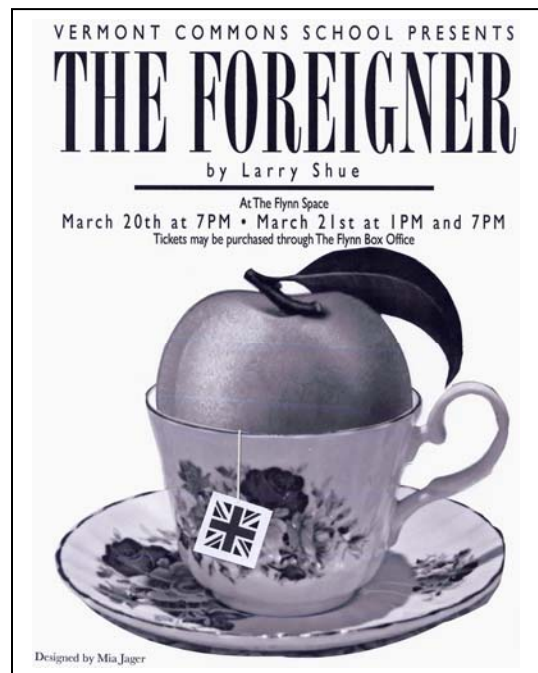
March 21st & 22nd at The Flynn Space in Burlington
